Rabbits have been domesticated for many thousands of years, even kept as pets by kings and queens.




Lops are known for their floppy ears.




Dwarfs are the smallest breeds.



Rex rabbits have soft, velvety fur.








Some rabbits are no breed in particular, but they still make excellent pets.

Every rabbit has its' own personality. Some can be fierce, others are shy. Given time and respect, your rabbit will learn to trust you.












Rabbits have good hearing and eyesight which they use to explore their surroundings.




Rabbits love grooming themselves just like cats do, but sometimes they need a little extra help!







To stay healthy, your rabbit will need fresh food every day. Clean water is also important.








Rabbits are really cool!




Here are some guidelines for drawing your own manga rabbit.

2. Finish the face and add the neck.




3. Next, your rabbit will need some stylish clothes
